You can use these alphabet cards in SO many ways!

- *Match the flashcards to the corresponding lower case wooden letter*
- *Turn each one over and say, e.g. "u' says u in umbrella"*
 - *the first time, use the letter name, the second time, say the letter sound*
- *Put them in alphabetical order*
- *Print two sets and use them to play 'snap'*
 - *the player who says the letter name/sound/word first wins (one, two or all three can be required as players gain confidence)*
